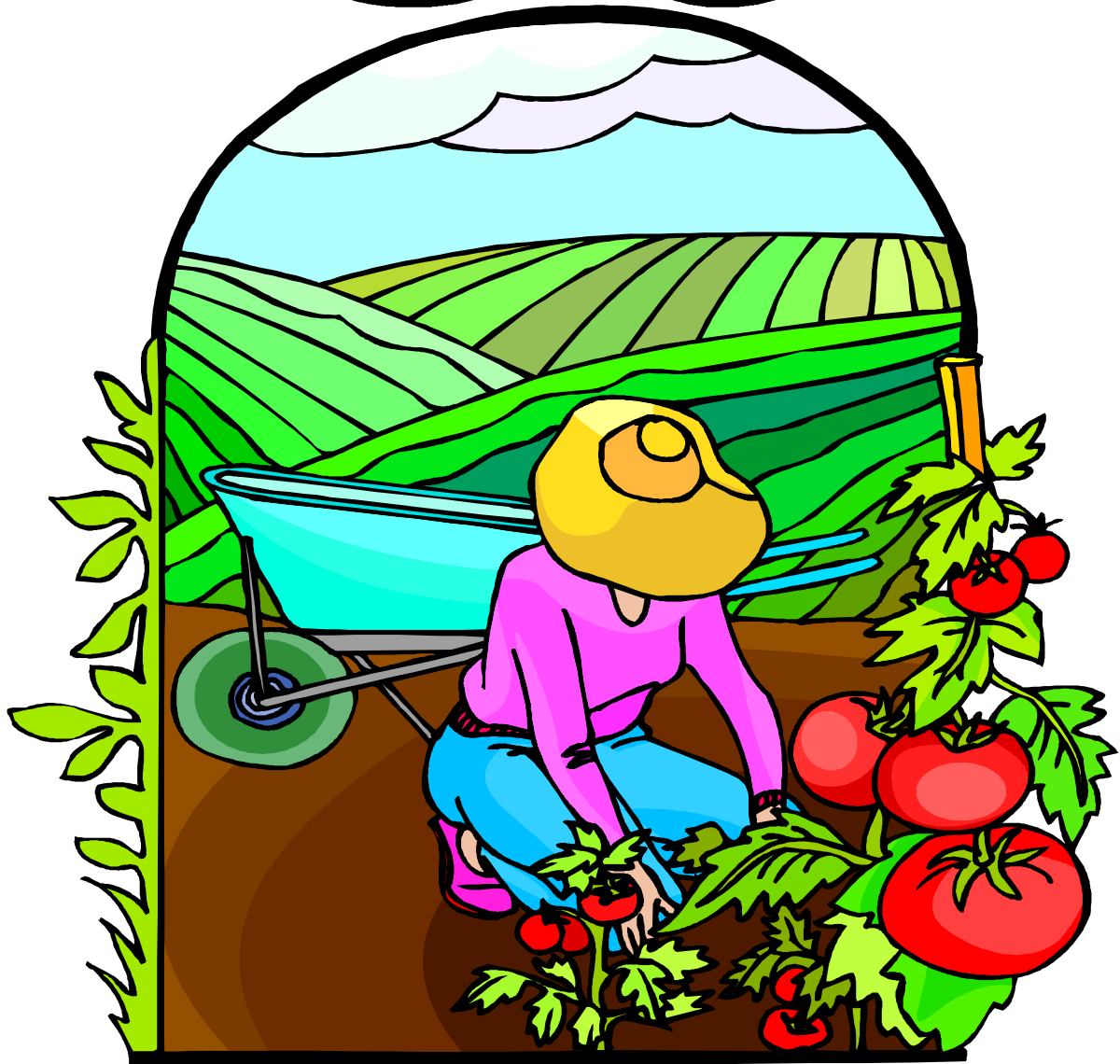
A is for animals. Many different kinds of animals are kept on farms.

and sheep shelter in barns.

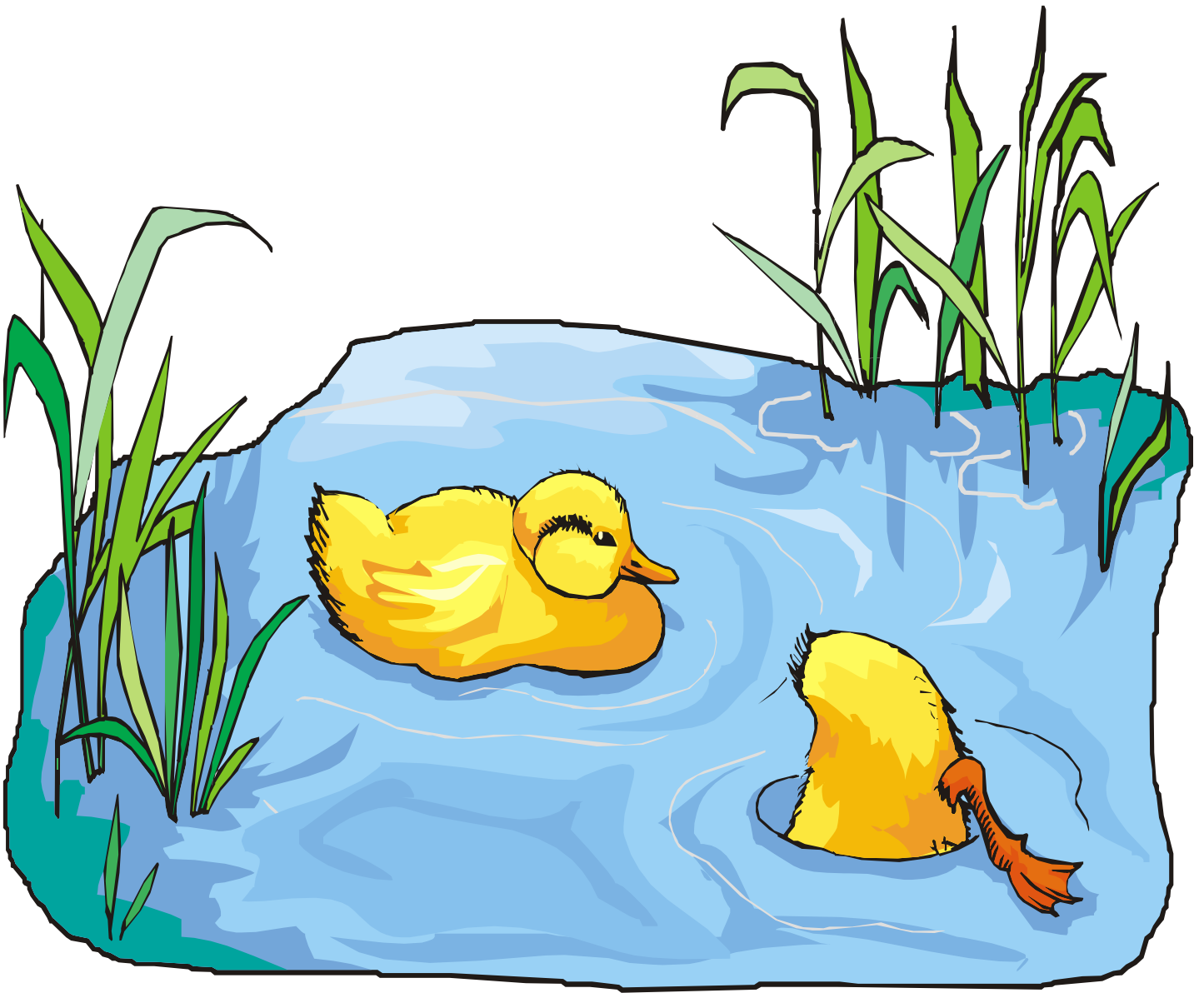

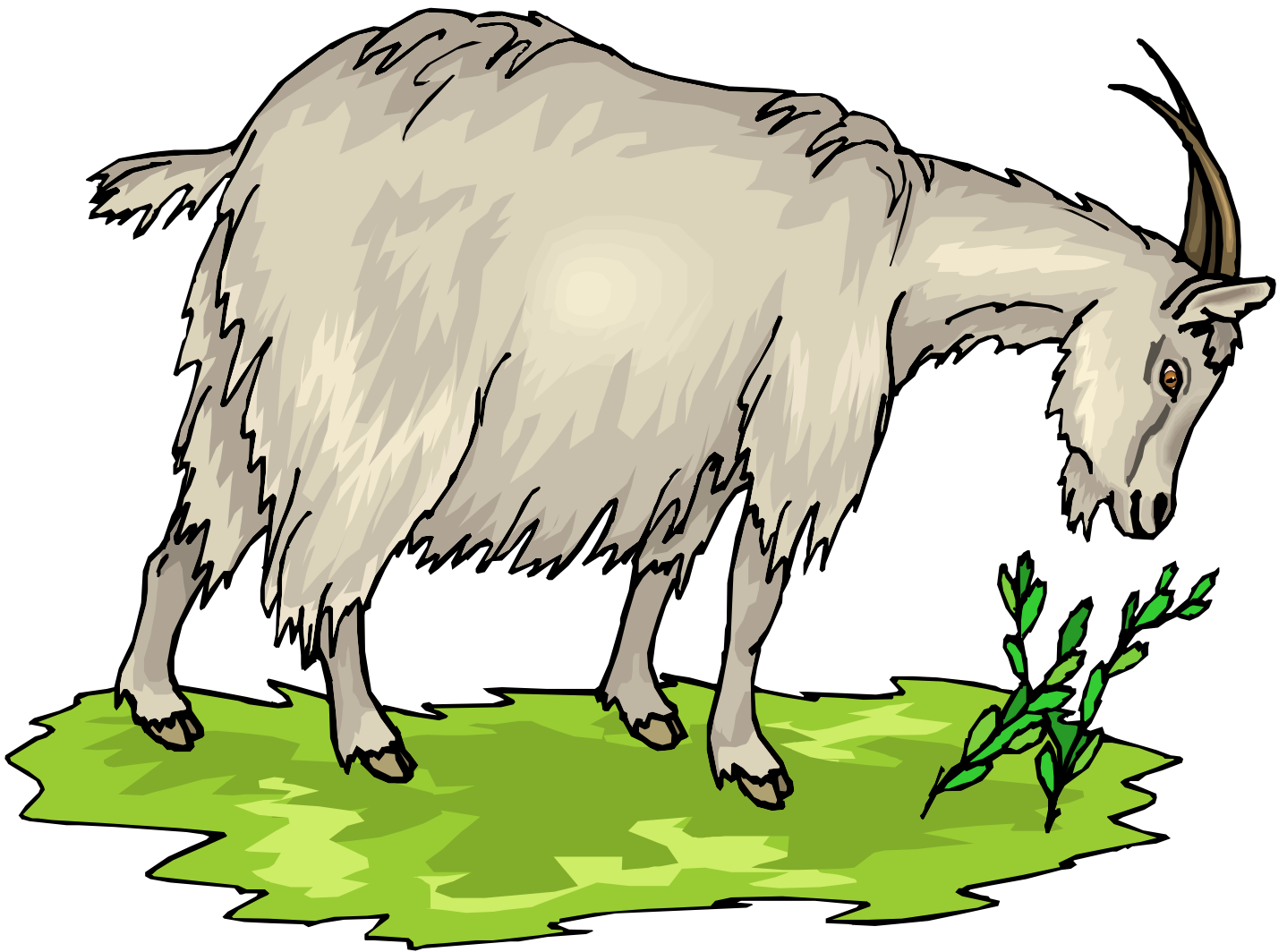
E is for eggs.

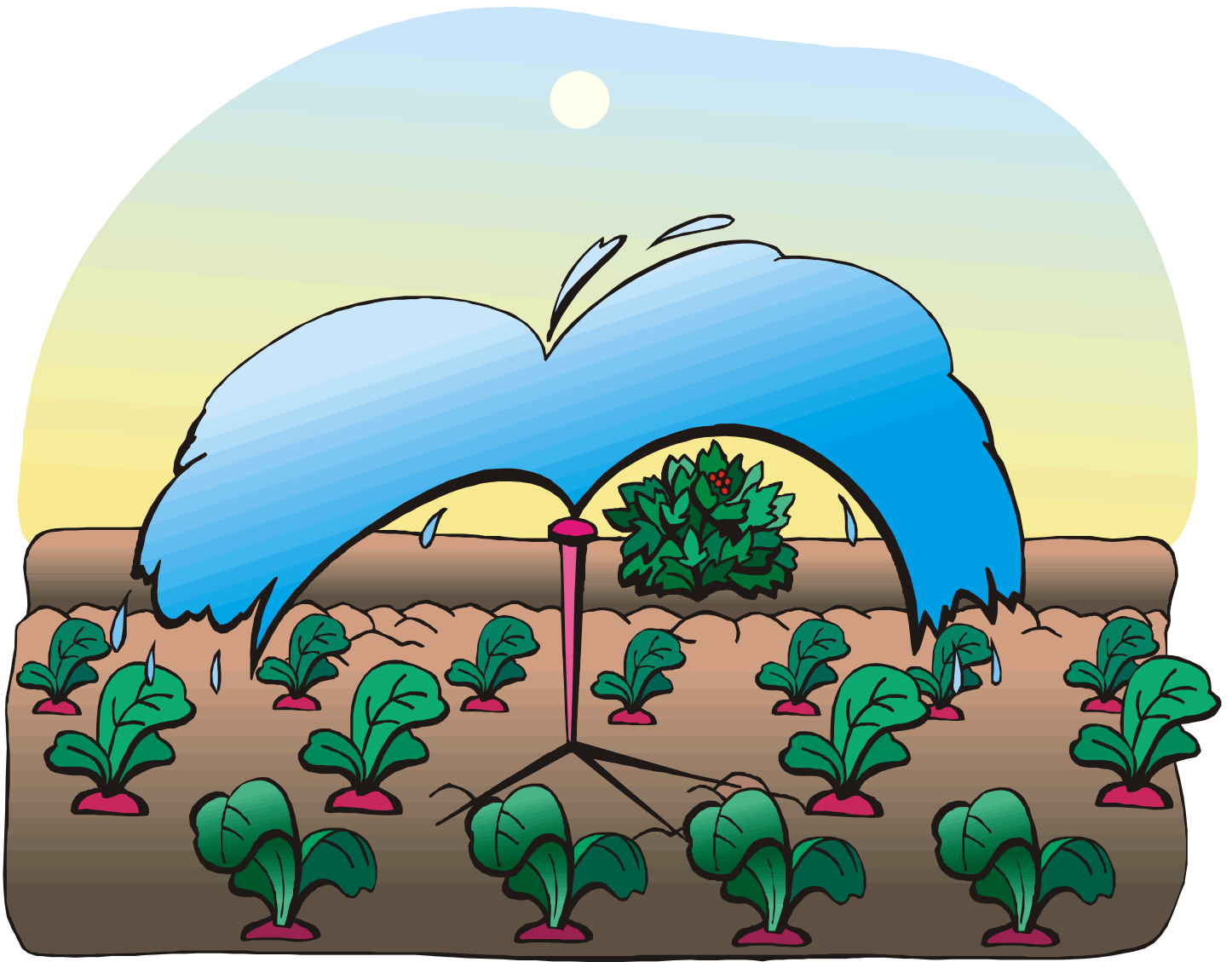
G is for goat.

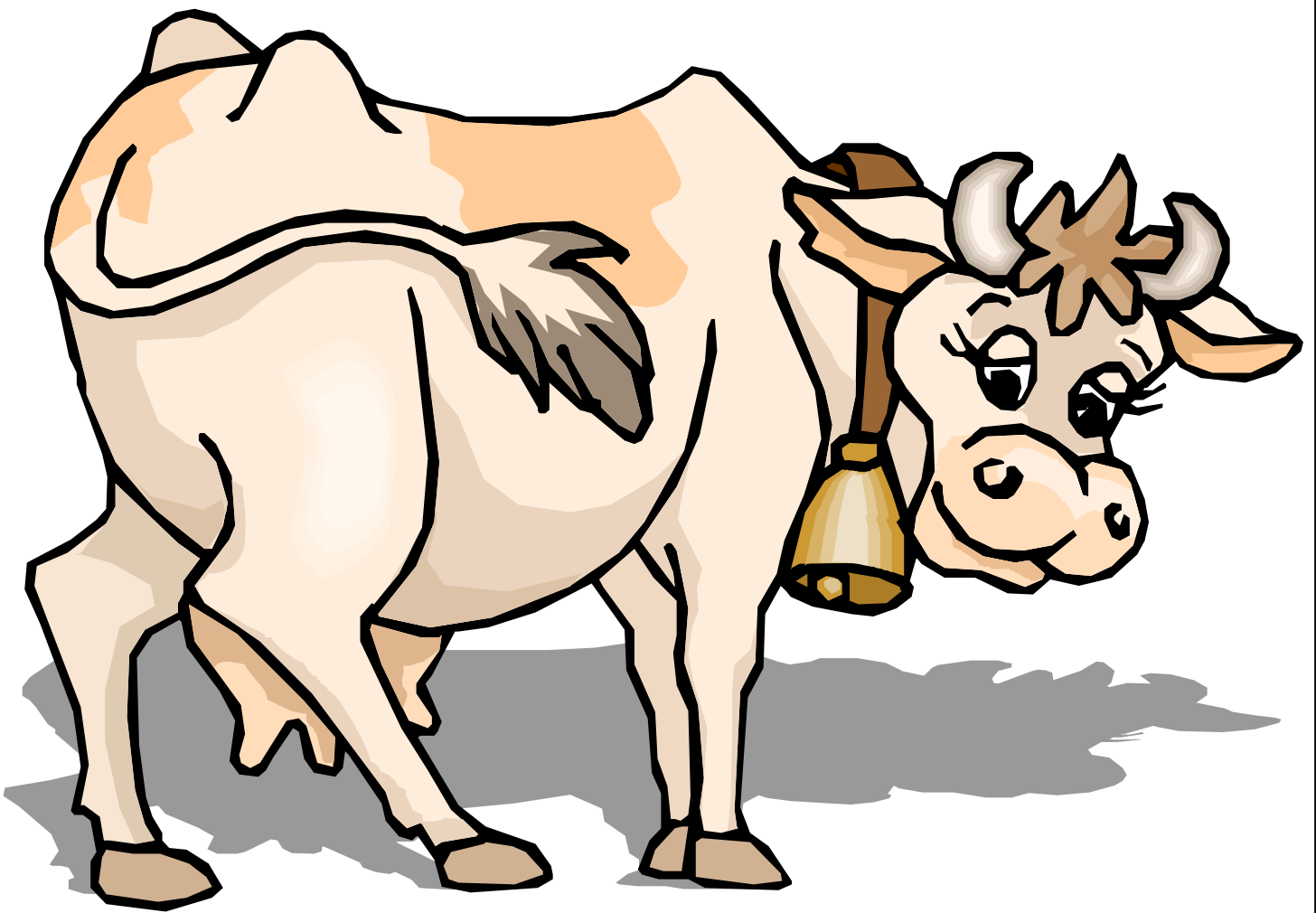
H is for hay.

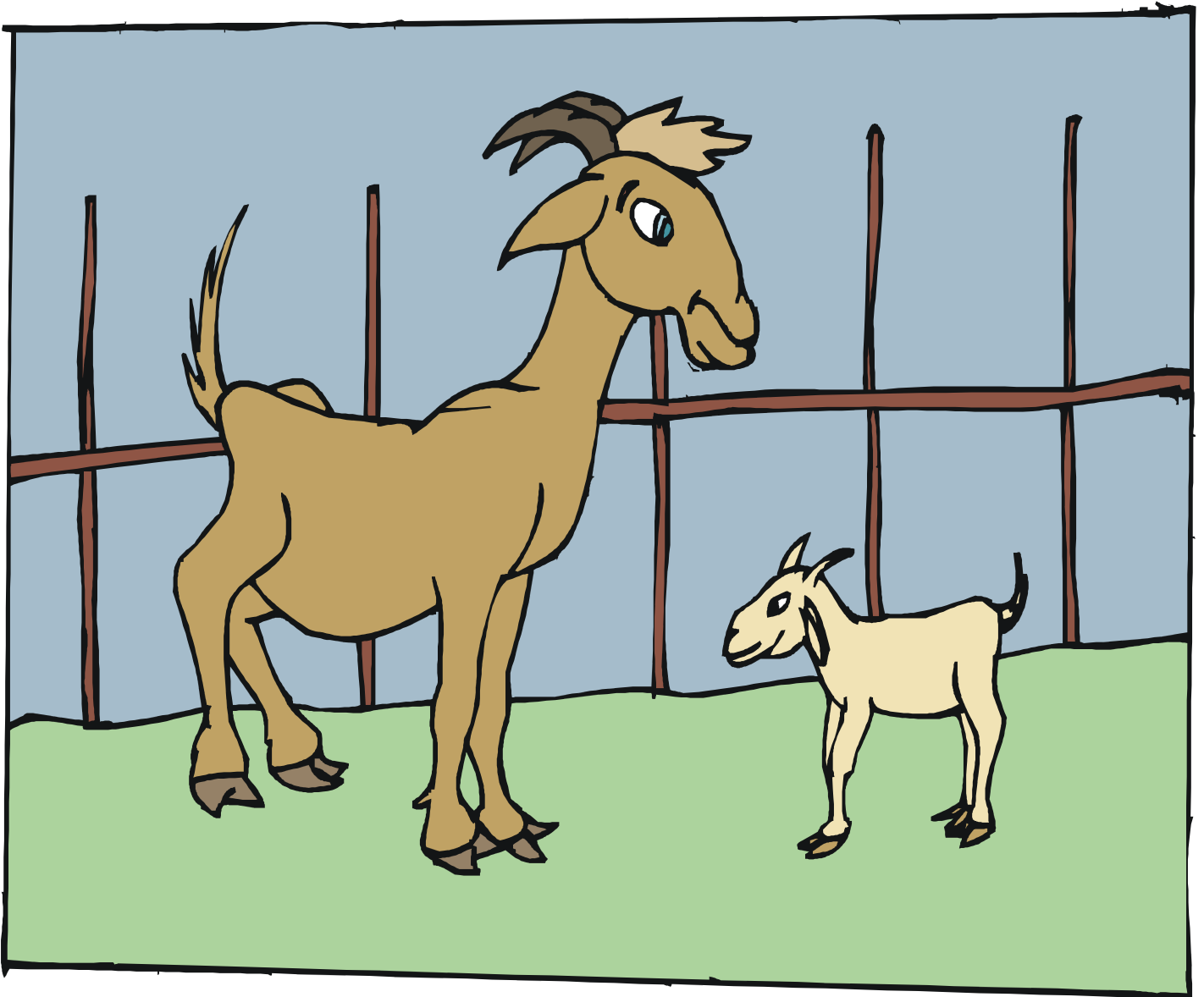
I is for irrigation.

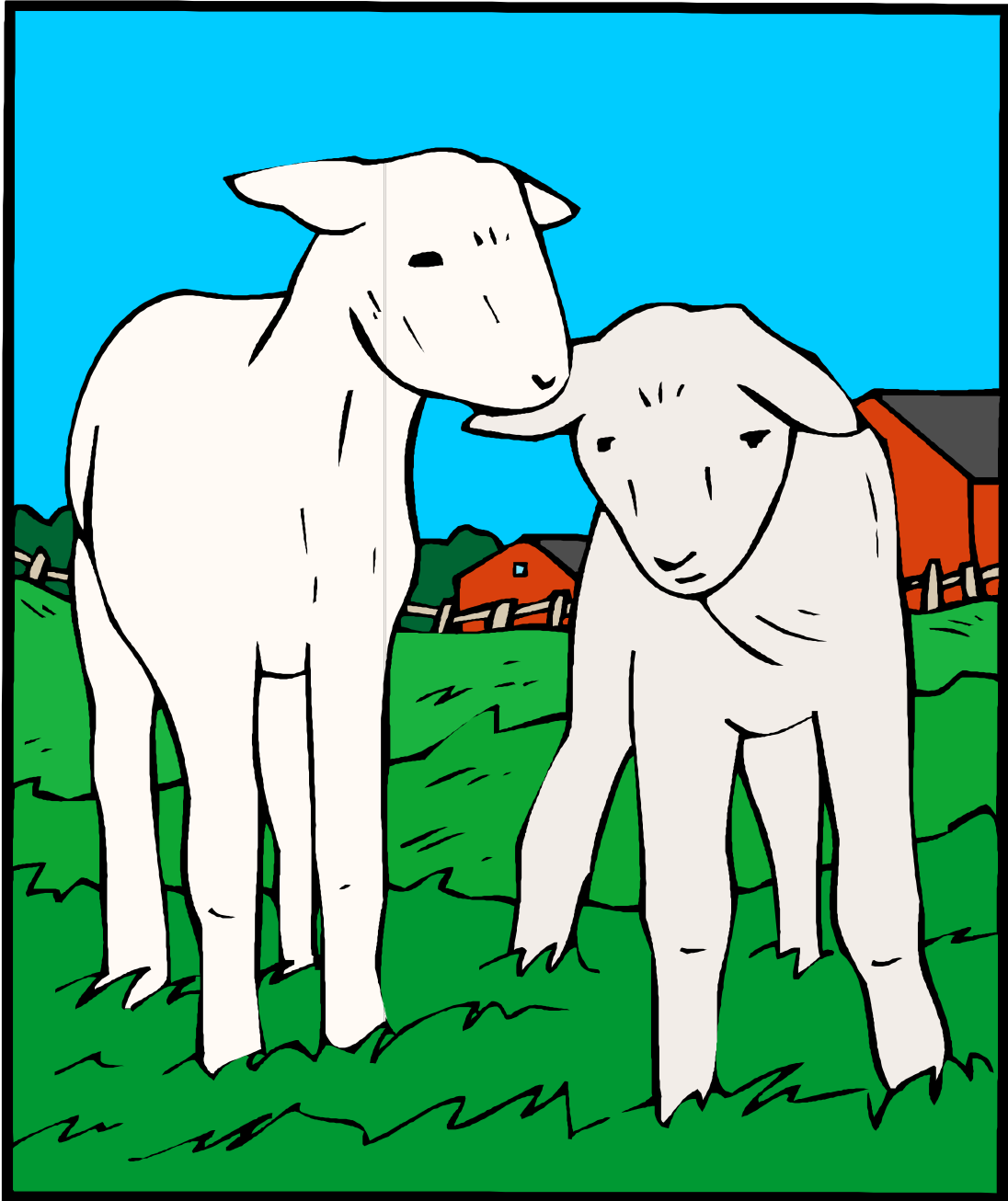
J is for Jersey cow.

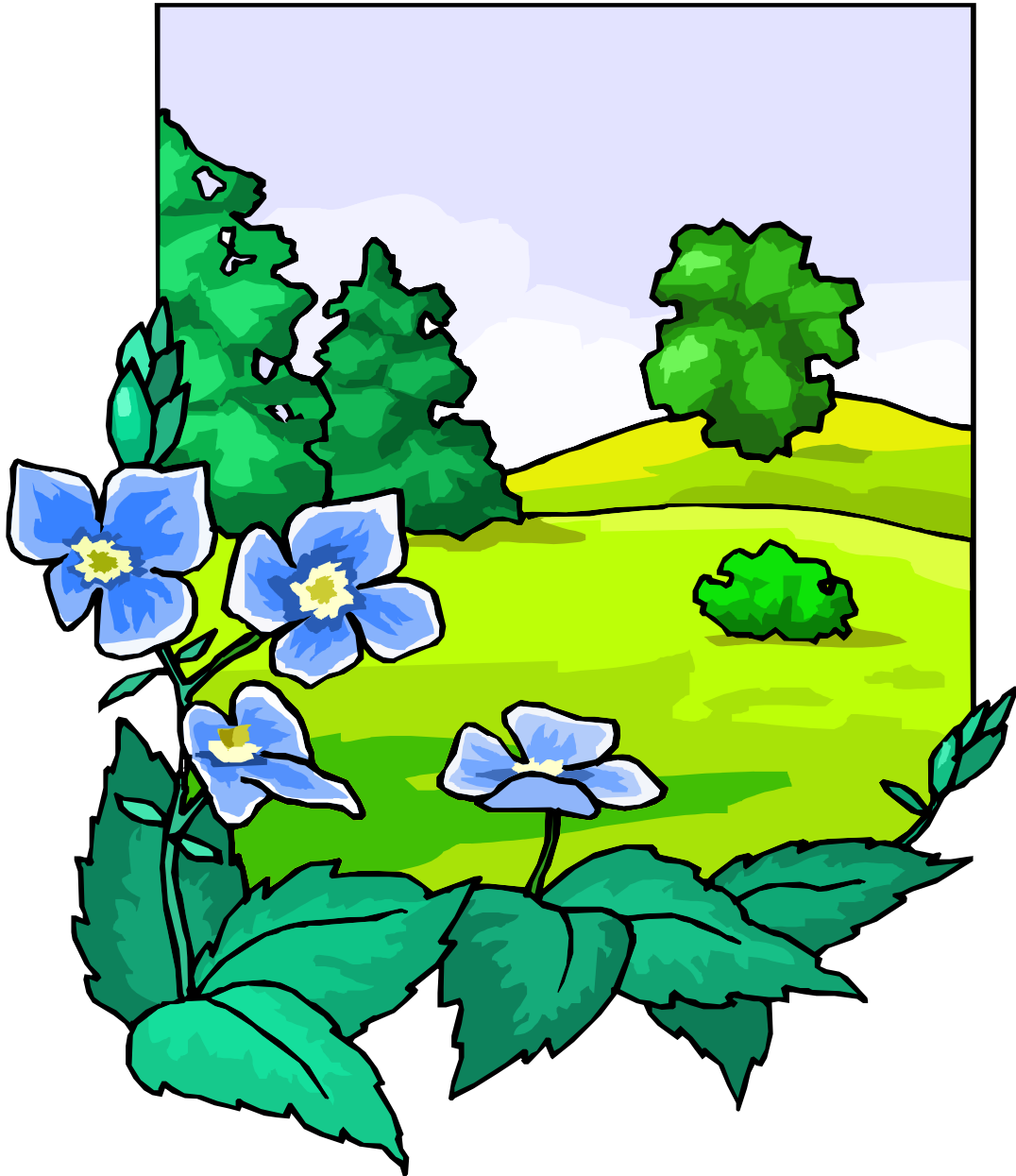
K is for kid.

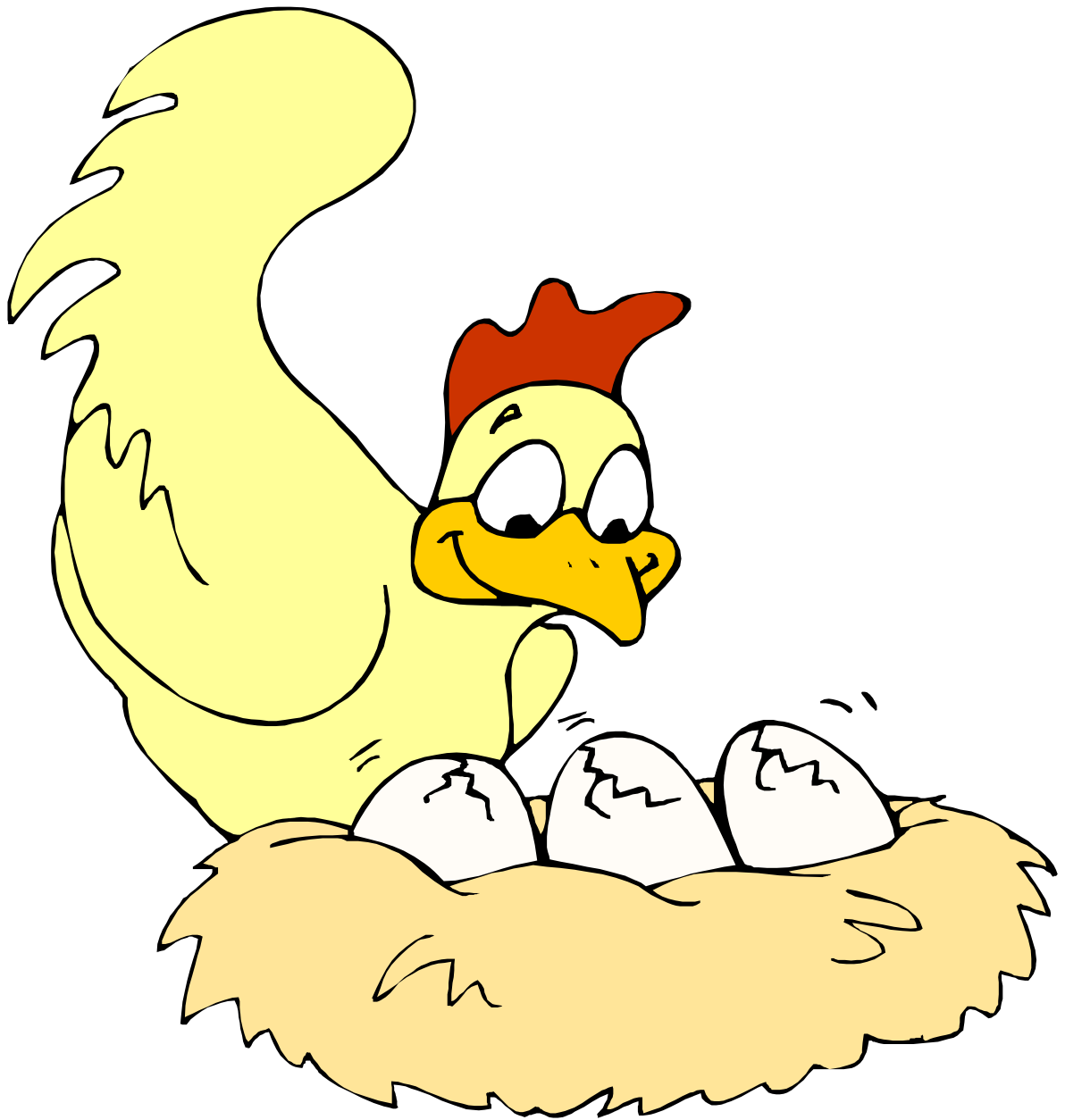
L is for lamb.

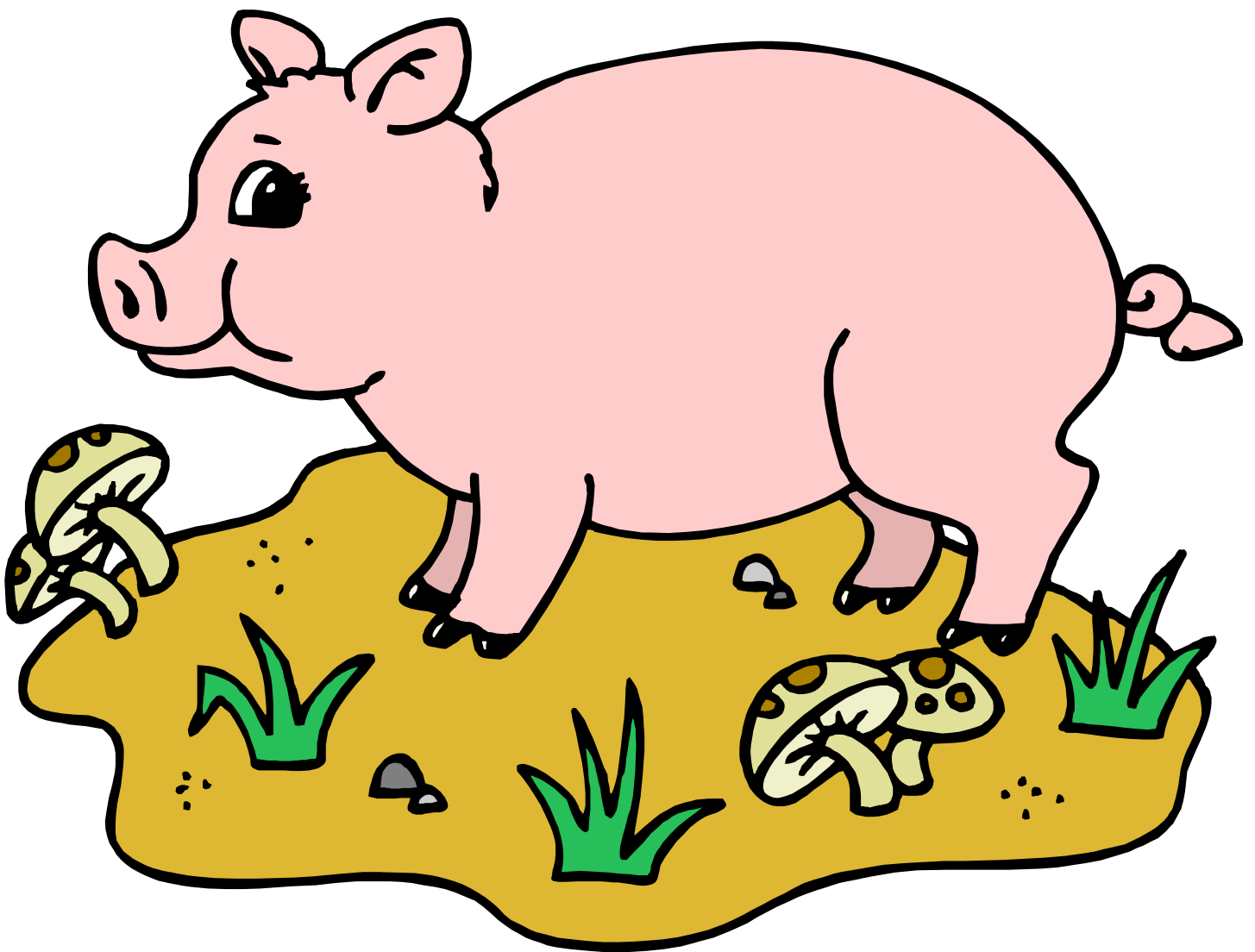
N is for nest.

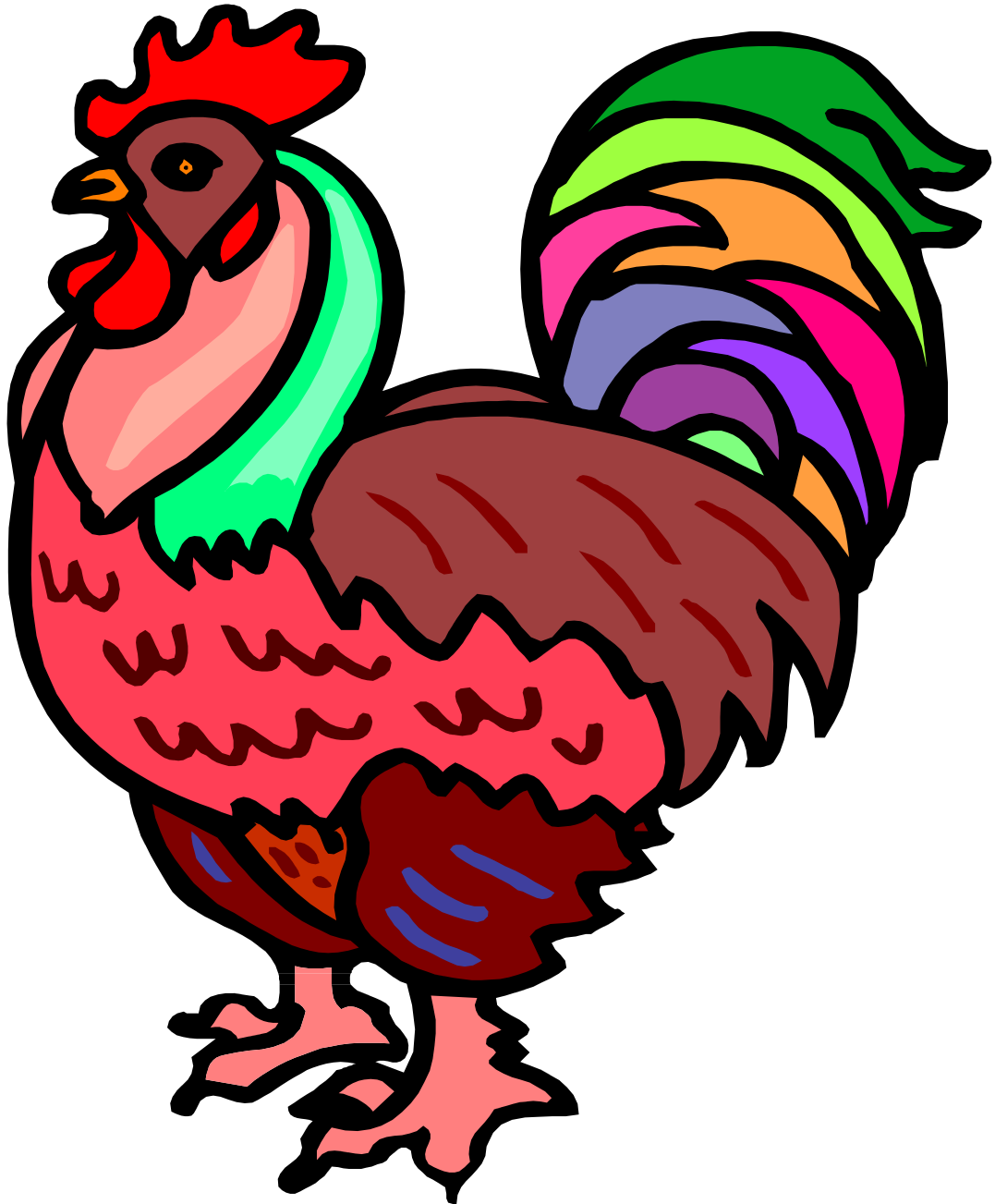
P is for pig.

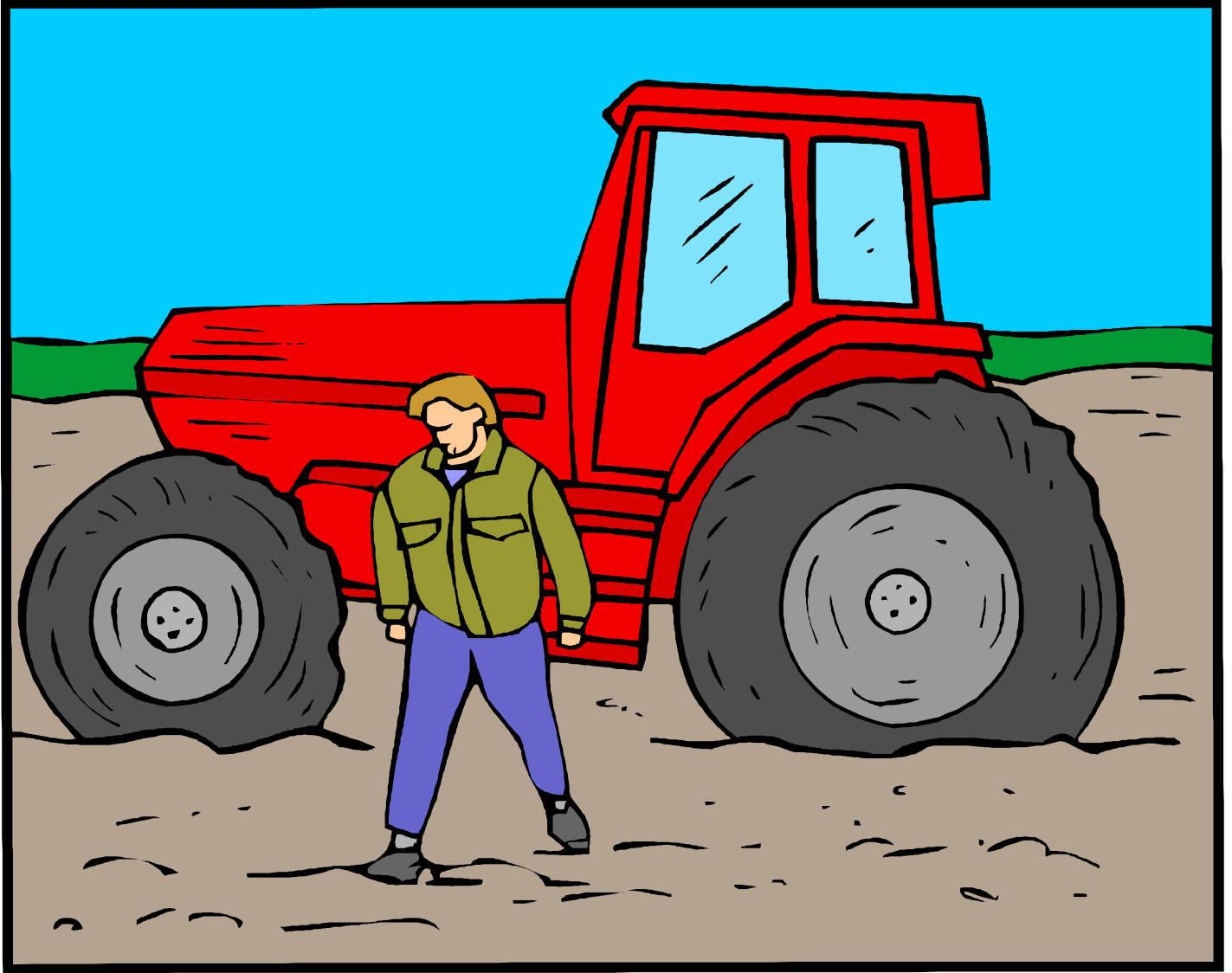
R is for rooster.

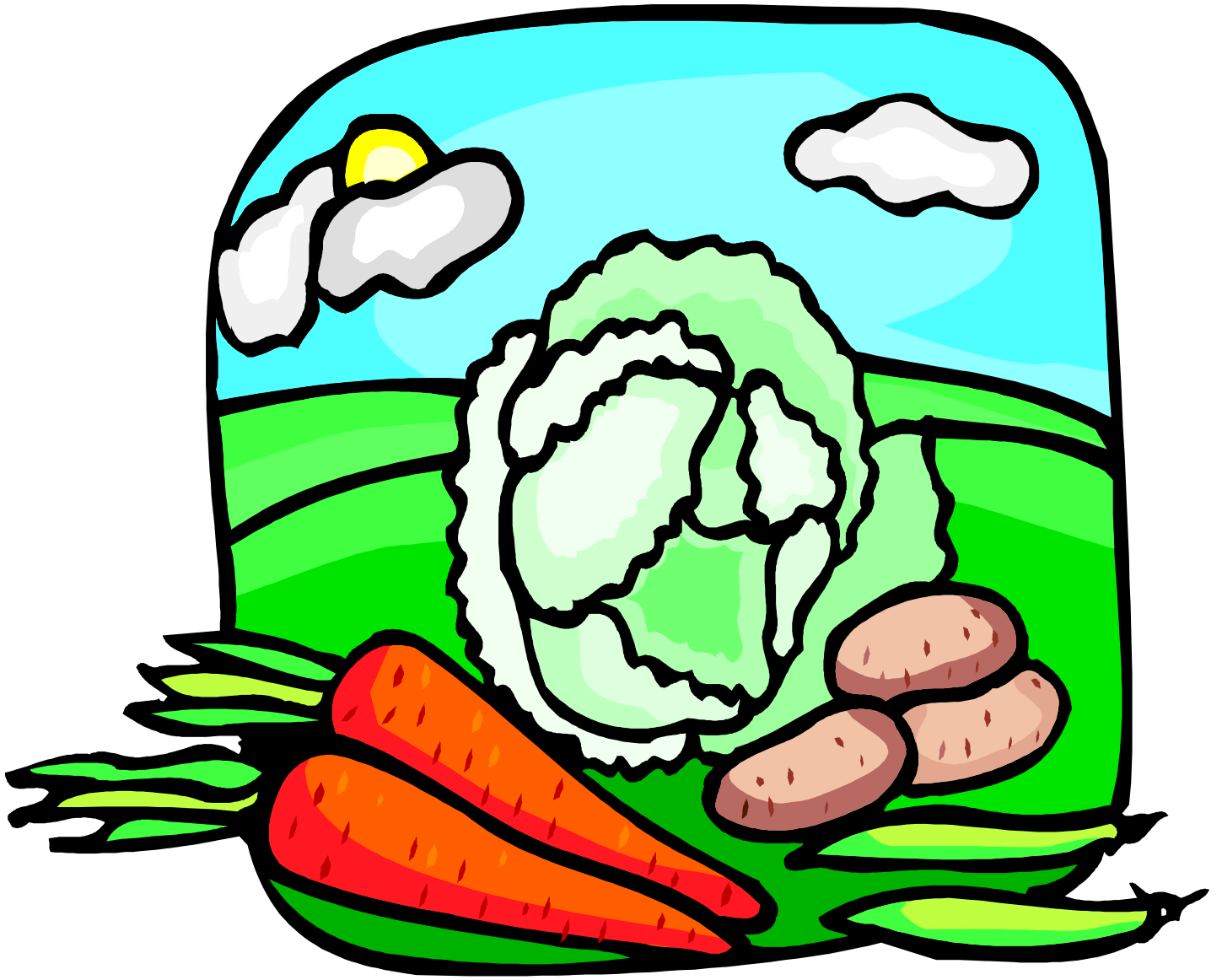
T is for tractor.

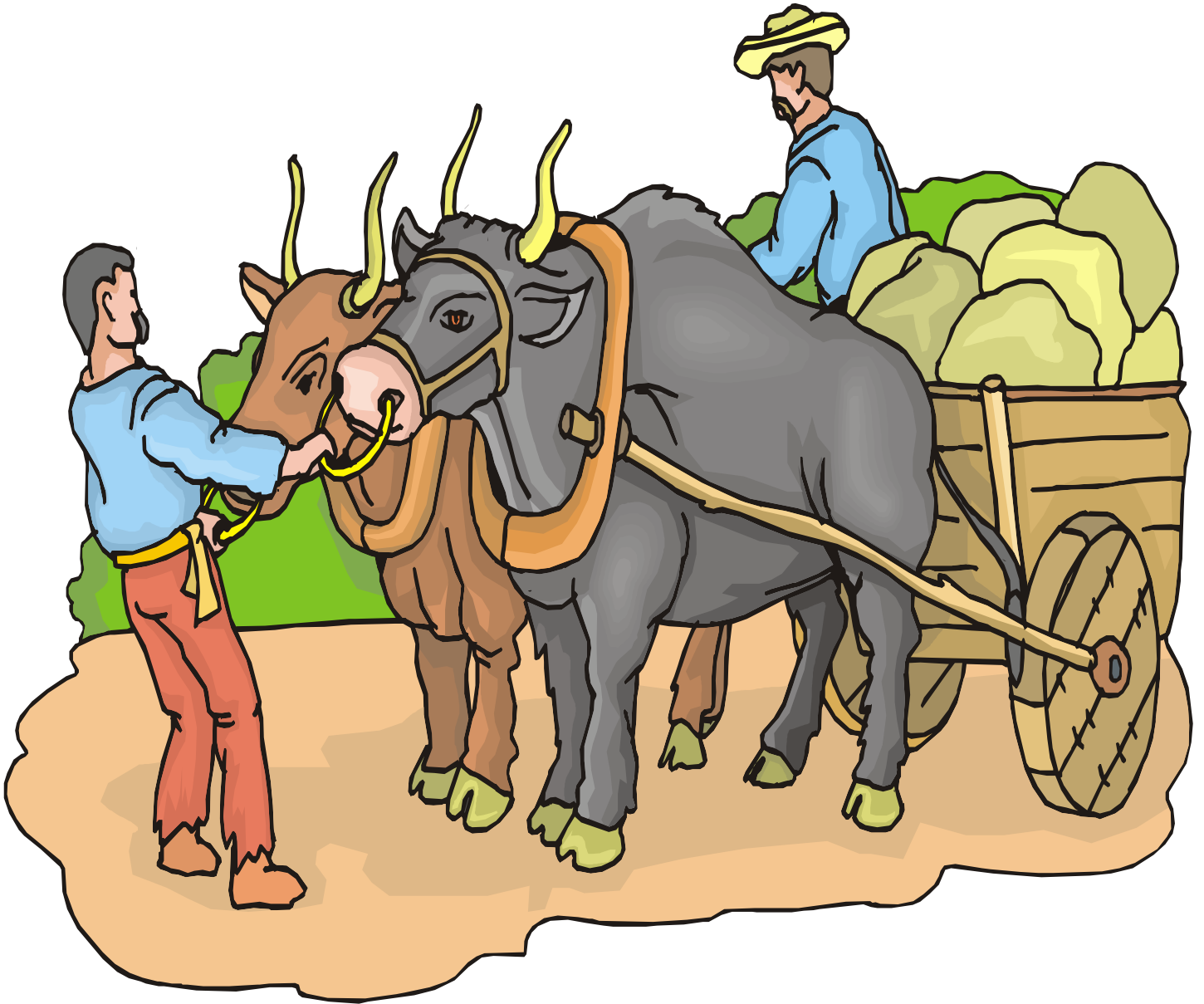
V is for vegetables.

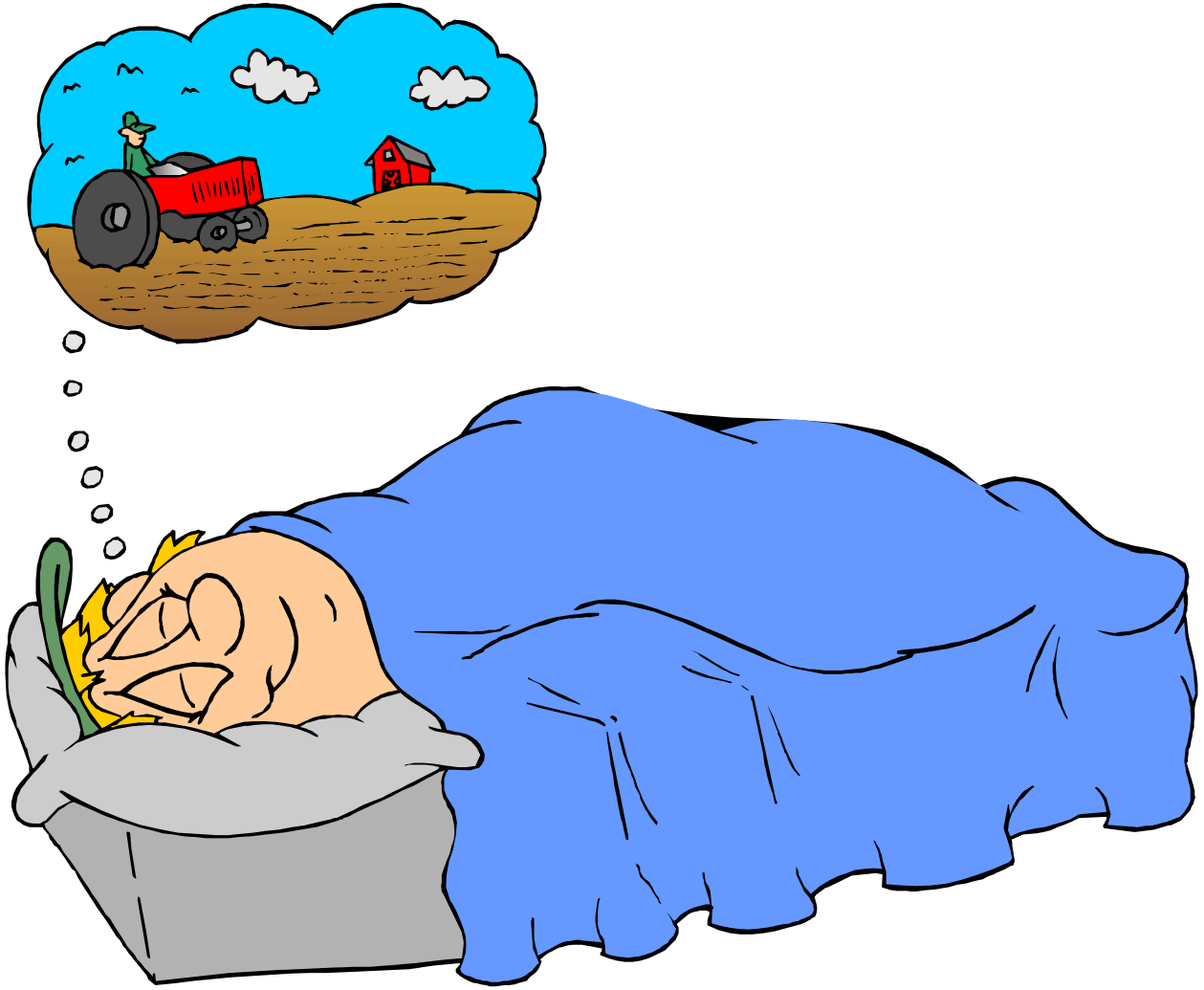
X is in oxen.
