

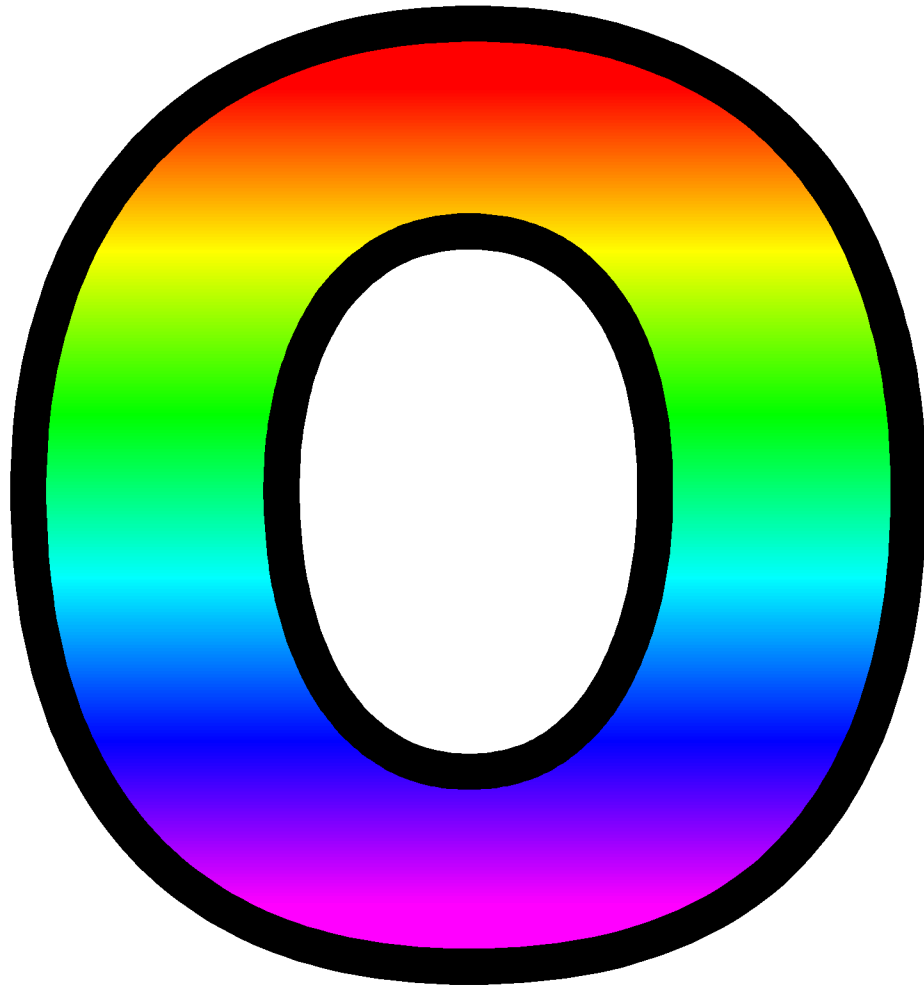
# Marking Symbols





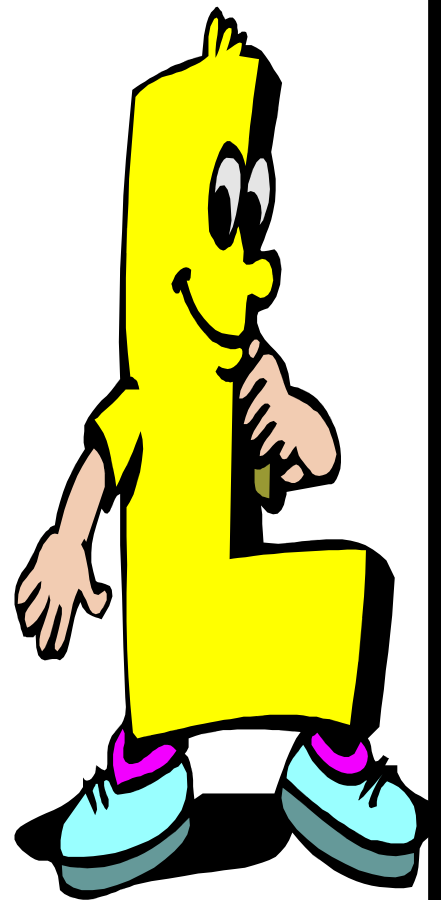
## **SPELLING MISTAKE**

An **S** will be put through the incorrectly spelt word and the correction will be written in the margin. Related errors of the same spelling, in the same piece of work, will be underlined.



## **PUNCTUATION / CAPITAL LETTER ERROR**

The punctuation error, misuse of a capital letter, or absence of a capital letter will be circled.





## **NO PARAGRAPHS**

This symbol is used to show where a new paragraph should begin. An explanation may also be put in the margin, eg. new place, new time, new subject etc.

# OMISSION

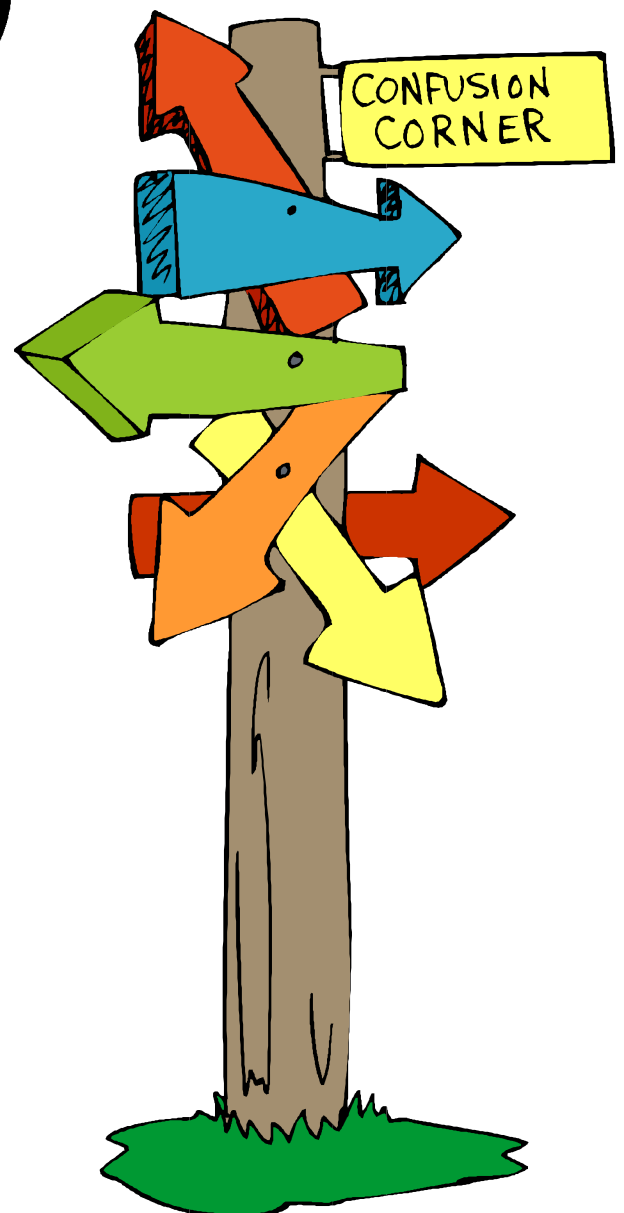

# CONFUSING

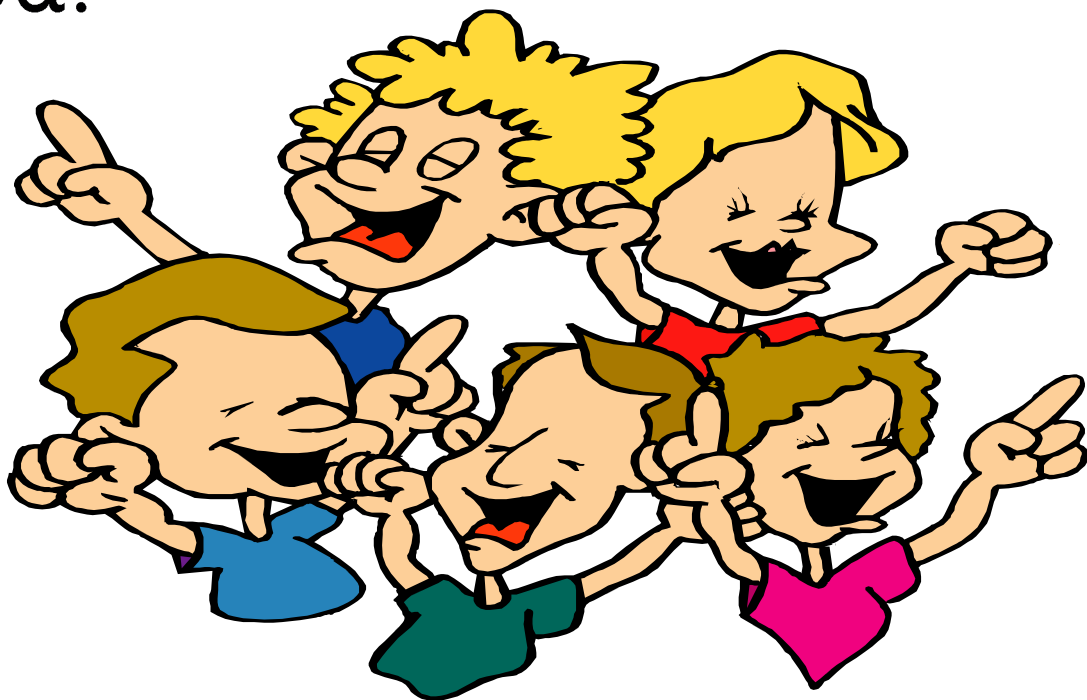
