











Can you match the names of the Roman gods and goddesses to their descriptions?

The Romans had a mid-winter festival held in my honour which lasted for seven days. Schools and businesses would close, parents gave toys to children, and there was a public banquet.



I quard the gate of Heaven, so I became god of doors and gates. I am very important because a house is only as strong as its doors. I have two faces, one looking forwards and the other looking back. The first month of the year is named after me because that is a time when we look back at the last year, and forward to the next.
